About us

Red Misericordia is a Non-Profit Association that, through various programs, provides social services to children and adolescents who are in vulnerable or high-risk conditions and/or are victims of abuse, aiming to achieve a positive transformation in their physical, mental, social, academic, and spiritual development through individualized comprehensive care.

Since 2011, through an agreement with the Public Ministry and with the collaboration of the social, public, and private sectors, Red Misericordia has managed to shelter and transform the lives of more than **1,600 minors** and provide services to urgent external cases related to the vulnerability of Dominican children. Currently, we house more than **160** children and adolescents and have successfully guided and trained over **600 pregnant teenagers**.

HOGAR MISERICORDIA

Hogar Misericordia is a program of Red Misericordia that, with the support of the Public Prosecutor's Office, provides shelter to more than 160 babies, children, and young girls who are in vulnerable conditions and/or high-risk situations, offering them comprehensive care to foster a positive change in their physical and psychosocial development.

The care is based on individualized attention that provides protection, health, food, clothing, and academic training, developing a model of a dignified life rooted in Christian values.

Impact of our service

Red Misericordia continues to contribute in the transformation of the lives of children and adolescents in the Dominican Republic.

Since 2021, we have impacted the lives of 282 children by reintegrating them into society, creating a family structure for them or connecting them to their family structure of origin.

-  ADHD


Academic deficiency:

Transformation Process



ADAPTATION

Upon arriving at Hogar Misericordia, each minor is admitted and evaluated in the adaptation area. This process ensures that, once the child is ready both physically and psychosocially, they can be integrated into the appropriate group.

aléria

Amor, Luz, Esperanza, Restauración y Alegría

The adaptation area includes a specialized space for newly admitted minors. Aleria is equipped with trained staff to assess and improve the physical, mental, and educational health of these children, who arrive in vulnerable conditions and/or have been victims of physical, sexual, or psychological abuse. They receive individualized attention, training, and orientation until they are successfully integrated with the other children at Hogar Misericordia.

After their time in the adaptation phase, the children are integrated into different group sections based on their age and gender. These spaces are designed to provide comprehensive care, including lodging, protection, food, clothing, initial and ongoing academic education, healthcare, and therapy with specialized personnel in each area.



CASITA: 0-4 years

Mamá Canguro: Area with trained staff for the care and specialized attention of premature infants and newborns under 3 months old.

Génesis: Area dedicated to the care of babies under 2 years old.

Moisés: A group section focused on the care of infants aged 2-4 years.



HOGAR: 5-8 years

Esther: Area dedicated to the comprehensive care of girls starting at 5 years old.

Gedeón: Area dedicated to the comprehensive care of boys starting at 5 years old.

VIDA is a program by Red Misericordia that provides guidance and training on the care of the mother and her baby during pregnancy, focusing on hygiene, nutrition, preparation for childbirth, and postpartum baby care.

VIDA was created in response to the high rates of teenage pregnancy, as well as maternal, juvenile, and neonatal mortality in the Dominican Republic. These rates are driven by risks associated with malnutrition, lack of hygiene, and a lack of knowledge about the necessary care and medical attention during pregnancy.

The goal of our program is to reduce maternal, juvenile, and neonatal mortality by providing pregnant adolescents with guidance and training on how to care for themselves and their babies.

Currently, we have three centers: **VIDA** Cienfuegos (2) and **VIDA** Pekín, where we offer support and guidance through workshops led by trained medical staff, with the help of volunteers and a comprehensive structure for the care and restoration of victims.

VIDA offers these adolescents the hope of a better life, enabling them to develop new patterns of behavior in an environment that helps restore their psychosocial and emotional security. Additionally, the program includes educational and vocational training to support their future job placement through an agreement with *Infotep* and the support of *Inaipi*.

VISIÓN DE ESPERANZA

Vision of Hope (VEA) is a program by Red Misericordia specifically designed for pregnant adolescents who are victims of abuse and lack the necessary tools or a suitable place to navigate their pregnancy.

This residential facility has the capacity to house up to 24 adolescents, providing them with the comprehensive care they need during their pregnancy. After the baby is born, the program continues with vocational training, accompanying them until they achieve reintegration into society and the workforce.


VEA offers abused adolescents training and counseling to protect themselves from future abuse. The program addresses various components to achieve social, physical, psychological, and economic restoration.

VISIÓN DE ESPERANZA

The programs include promoting peaceful behavior, preventing domestic violence, teaching conflict resolution, and training for mother-child bonding, all aimed at preventing child abuse.

A MULTI-SECTORAL EFFORT

VEA works in partnership with the public-private sector to ensure that any adolescent who is a victim of domestic violence or feels threatened receives the effective care and comprehensive attention they need.

CEMIVIDA: School located across from RM, providing high-quality, inclusive, and continuous academic training to the children in our programs, the children of our employees, and children from the community, starting at age 2. CEMIVIDA ensures their academic development through core subjects, English, art, technology, social studies, Christian education, and psychosocial training.
